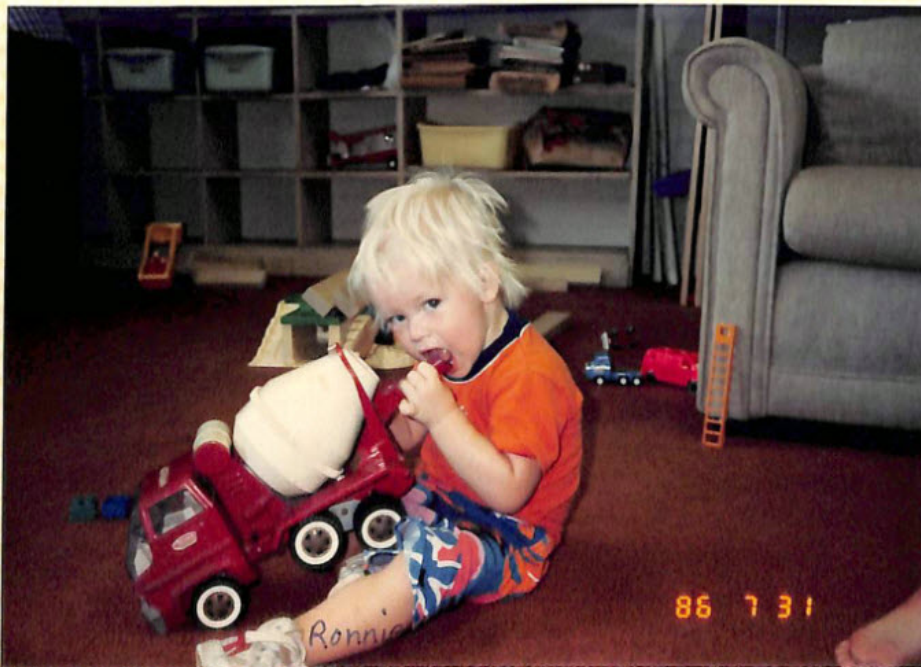
FAMILY CARE MINISTRY CONTINUES IN 1986
